"Preparatory work for the modernisation of public sector financial accounting systems on an accruals basis"

Aim: financial support for MSs to carry out work linked to modernisation of public sector financial accounting systems under accruals basis with a view to the eventual implementation of EPSAS

Scope: primarily MSs that do not as yet apply accruals across public sector; also those MSs already using accruals that are moving towards harmonised financial accounting systems across government

Target group: MS' public sector accounting regulators. In particular, public sector standard-setters and entities with a responsibility for leading/ coordinating implementation of public sector accounting standards across government sub-sectors

List of possible tasks in the proposal

- 1) Scoping of modernisation needs
- 2) Developing the organisation of the project to implement changes
- 3) Developing an approach to implementation
- 4) Developing a stakeholder communication plan
- 5) Exchanging knowledge and best practices
- 6) Building on existing analyses: take steps to implement accruals-based financial accounting systems across public sector
